set up, to cooking, serving and cleaning up. Finally, the Rural Mental Health Project for the funding of this event. **None of this would have been possible without this collective effort!**

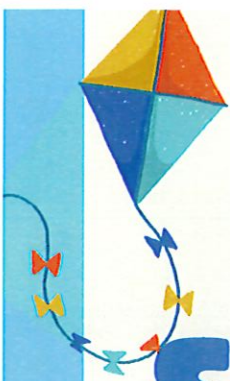
